## Message From The Principal

This week we were able to unveil our newest addition to the school with some colourful activity line markings. Our students have already taken to them with excitement and it has been great to see them enjoying the new down ball courts, snakes and ladders, dance class, the activity trail, the "Mamba" alphabet snake and hopscotch. First thing this morning we had many students checking out the new logo and map of Australia on the main entry path, with quite a few learning what the letters "ACT" stood for on the map!



### Leaving a Vehicle in the Kiss and Go Zone

Of recent times, more and more parents appear to be leaving their vehicles in the Kiss and Go Zone during drop off and pick up times. Not only is this illegal, it hampers the attempts of other parents to come and go in an efficient matter, as the cars inevitably prevent other cars from moving as far forward as possible. Please respect the parking restrictions and assist your fellow parents by staying with your car in these zones. If you wish to enter the school, there is plenty of parking available at Gladeswood Reserve, further down Gladeswood Drive and on Maygrove Way.

I would also add that double parking is also illegal and incredibly unsafe. There has been a noticeable rise in this practice of late and it's not acceptable. It blocks traffic, promotes children moving between vehicles that may move off suddenly and reduces the line of sight for the crossing supervisor.

It's important that we act as role models for all of the students in and around the school, so please, consider the safety and convenience of the broader community when driving around the school.

### Prime Energy Drinks

We have noticed these drinks being brought into school more and more often. To be very clear, student drink bottles must only contain water. Tetra packs of orange juice or milk are suitable for lunch times, but outside of this, no other sports, energy, soft or adult beverages should be brought to school. In particular, no student should bring any Prime products to school for any purpose. Even the basic "Prime Hydration" is not recommended for children under the age of 15, so clearly there is no need for the drinks here. Should students be seen with Prime drinks at school, they will be confiscated, parents notified and required to collect the drinks, otherwise they will be disposed of.

### Reports and Student-Parent-Teacher Conferences

With school reports becoming available **via Xuno on Thursday June 22nd**, we have taken the opportunity of this unusually short term to think about our reporting model. Rather than provide parents with a written and verbal report on the same content, this year we will be pushing our conferences back to later in **Term 3 on Tuesday August 29th**, so as to be able to provide an update on each child's progress over the term. This will be in conjunction with each child's Individual Education Plan which will be provided close to the conferences. This model will provide parents with an update on their child's learning towards the end of each term, either by written or verbal communication. The aim of which is to better ensure that parents are aware of their child's individual point of need and that our teachers are teaching to it.



### End of Term 2

The school year is in full swing and the end of Term 2 is nearly upon us. Students will be dismissed for the school holidays on **Friday June 23rd at 2:30pm**. I would again remind parents that if you cannot collect your child at this time, care is available via Camp Australia.

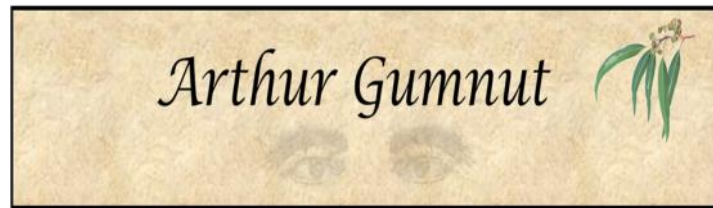

**Tickets are \$20.00 each for adults and \$15 for concession (senior/student/child).** Children 2 years and under do not require a ticket but must be seated on a parent's lap; they will not have their own seat. To ensure that all parents have the opportunity to watch the show, **we request that no more than four tickets are purchased per family across the two nights.**

Any unsold tickets will be released to all families to purchase shortly.

**\*\*All students will be performing on both nights and do not require a ticket.**

Ensure you review your ticket selection before submitting and confirming your order. Subject to the provisions for cancelled and/or postponed shows, there are no exchanges or refunds once a ticket has been purchased.

Programs can be purchased by choosing the option when purchasing tickets. All pre-bought programs will be distributed the day before the production. Programs will also be available at the kiosk on the night for \$3.00.

**Please ensure you print out your tickets and bring them on the night or have them on a smart phone to show on entry.**

Our venue is **Wheeler Auditorium, Nazareth College, 17-21 Manning Drive, Noble Park North.** Car parking is available at the college and in the surrounding streets.

**Students need to arrive at the theatre between 5:45pm and 6:00pm.** Signs will be provided on the night to direct you to the drop off area. The show will commence at 6.30pm sharp. Main cast are required to arrive at **5.15pm.**

Students will be backstage the entire night and DO NOT require a ticket. At a later date, we will provide information regarding a rehearsal at the theatre (which will be during school hours).
