Message From The Principal

World Teachers Day

World Teachers Day is celebrated this **Friday**, **October 27**th throughout Australia. At Mulgrave PS we are lucky to have highly dedicated educators (Teachers and Education Support staff) who continue to support the social, emotional and academic development of our students. We'd like to acknowledge them and thank them for the contribution they make to our school.

School Library & STEM Centre – Stage 2 Works

Last week the school commenced the official planning for our stage 2 works, the \$6.06m redevelopment of the old hall into a new library and STEM centre, plus a new northeast car park and drop off zone. The initial kick off meeting brought the Victorian School Building Authority, the recently appointed Principal Design Consultant, Tectura Architects, and the school together to identify a timeline for the project and plan the initial consultation phase. Tectura, armed with specific concept ideas, will work with students, staff and school council on behalf of the parent community, to develop a design for broader consultation. This will lead to full documentation and eventually a tender process to appoint a builder. All going according to plan, we expect construction to commence in the second half of 2024.

In addition, Tectura have also made a submission to Monash Council regarding the Gladeswood Reserve Redevelopment regarding our future carpark that will connect with the reserve near the tennis club and provide a new safe turning circle and drop off point where students will be able to leave their parents vehicles safely, in a dedicated no parking zone.

The coming months will be exciting as we plan a new learning hub that will support students for decades to come, bringing our library into the 21st century along with the resources required to meet the school's long term vision for STEM.

Step into Prep

We have now held our first and second Step into Prep sessions and both have seen an excellent turn out from families. Our newest students have enjoyed their sessions and already look like they are settled into their new environment. Over the course of the 4 sessions, we are able to gain a deeper understanding of our future preps and their learning needs, as well as identifying how various groupings socialise and collaborate in a classroom setting. As we continue the sessions in November, the teachers will begin to put class groups together, ahead of the Prep Parent Information evening on **Wednesday November 29**th **at 6:30pm**. We look forward to our next session on **Wednesday November 8**th **at 9:15am**.



Principal



Grass pollen season, which typically runs from October to December each year in Victoria, brings an increase in asthma and hay fever symptoms. It also increases the risk of thunderstorm asthma. For people with asthma or hay fever, especially those who experience wheezing or coughing with their hay fever, thunderstorm asthma can be sudden, serious and even life threatening.

Mulgrave Primary School will implement a range of measures to keep our school community safe as the risk of thunderstorm asthma increases.

Many of our staff are trained in asthma first aid, and we will monitor the Vic Emergency app to receive thunderstorm warnings, and, where appropriate, keep students indoors when weather forecasts identify greater risk.

During the season, there are some things you can do to prepare and protect yourself and your family:

- If your child has ever had asthma, talk to your doctor about what you can do to help protect them from the risk of thunderstorm asthma this pollen season, including updating your asthma action plan. Taking an asthma preventer properly and regularly is key to preventing asthma, including thunderstorm asthma.
- If your child has hay fever, see your pharmacist or doctor for a hay fever treatment plan and check if you should have an asthma reliever puffer. These are available from a pharmacy without a prescription.
- If your child has hay fever and experiences wheezing and coughing, it is important to make sure they don't also have asthma. Speak to your doctor about an asthma action plan.
- ♦ Where possible, avoid being outside during thunderstorms from October to December, especially during the wind gusts that come before the storm. Go inside and close your doors and windows. If you have your air conditioning on, turn it to 'recirculate'.

Protect yourself this pollen season – managing asthma and allergies matters.

** if your child suffers from hayfever , it is advised that you give them their medication prior to attending school in the morning.

EMOTIONAL SECURITY

One of the greatest gifts you can give your child is a felt sense of emotional security.

Children who feel delighted in as they explore their worlds, and cared for in their painful feelings, become emotionally secure.

You can help your child feel secure by supporting their exploration through play, imagination, and learning. You can also help your child feel secure by being available in times of need, when painful feelings overwhelm, and they reach out for comfort and care.

Helping your child gain the self-confidence needed to deal with failure, loss, shame, difficulty and defeat is as important – if not more so than feeling good or being the best.

When children trust themselves to handle painful feelings - fear, anger and sadness – they gain an inner security that allows them to embrace the world in which they live. The goal is to help children better understand their feelings and in doing so, gain greater autonomy and freedom over their lives.

Talking about feelings, teaches children that it is normal to feel sad, or angry or scared at times. With greater tolerance of painful feelings, children become free to enjoy their world to feel secure in their relations and to be happy.






