
Midyear Reports

Future Fundraising Targets

Following on from parent payments and also acknowledging budgets are tight everywhere, we are now moving on to a new fundraising target, following the success of the stadium air conditioning, which will be installed soon. With the stage 2 funding for the new Library and STEM centre building confirmed, we have recently worked with the architects and the Victorian Building Authority to bed down a budget and the drawings. The new building will be home to a brand new Art Room, Library, STEM classroom and a presentation space that will be utilised not only by

STEM classes, but by the whole school. This space will hopefully be equipped with retractable seating, that will allow us to use it as a multi-purpose space. The architectural design behind the space is incredibly well thought out, however as part of the project, we will receive a small furniture budget, and this budget will not cover the new retractable seating. The school will fund this item directly to ensure that we receive the full features of the design. Over the next 3 years, this will be our key fundraising goal and hopefully, we can raise \$60,000 between now and December 2026. I know the PFA do a power of work to support the school in this area and that they recently communicated with families around future fundraising opportunities. The big one each year is possibly also the most fun, with the Colour Fun Run coming up in Term 4. Please look out for these opportunities and we once again thank you for supporting our school.

40 KMH Sign

Families will have noted the temporary 40 kmh sign on Gladeswood Drive. Generally, if the sign appears, the council are noticing driving behaviours they'd like to change. Be safe on the roads out there and a reminder that the Kiss and Go area is 5 minute parking only and that families should not leave their vehicle, other than to get a school bag out of the boot. Walking away from your vehicle could see a driver receiving a fine from the Monash Council in the mail. Importantly, leaving your car to enter the school has a negative effect on the flow of the area, as it holds up other parents from coming and going. This often leads to traffic snarls and unsafe vehicle movements in the zone. Please be considerate of the safety of all community members when parking in the area.

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The Victorian State Schools Spectacular is a huge concert presented by the Victorian Department of Education, performed at John Cain Arena and broadcast on channel 7 in December. Thousands of government schools

participate in this event in many different ways including principal vocalists, dancers and speciality acts, the orchestra, a core choir, mass dancers, a mass choir and tech/backstage. Mulgrave PS has participated in the mass choir every second year since 2018 and mass dance in 2022.

This year, we have sixteen students participating in the mass dance and thirty students in the mass choir.



Both casts have been busy attending rehearsals before school two times a week. They have also begun rehearsals at Oakleigh South Primary School, with other students from nearby schools. Mass dance have two more of these rehearsals over the next few months, whist the mass choir will have rehearsals in the Melbourne Town Hall in July and August, where they will sing with the rest of the mass choir (approximately 1,300 students all up) and adding in the principal vocalists in August.


