School Uniform

If a child is unable to wear the correct school uniform, we ask that parents provide a note, either via email or Seesaw to advise the classroom teacher.

Wearing a parka over the school bomber jacket on the way to and from school or during recess and lunch is common sense.

We recognise that from time to time during winter, an item might not dry in time, so the note simply makes us aware.

We also have no objection to students wearing the outerwear (coats) of their choice on those cold days.

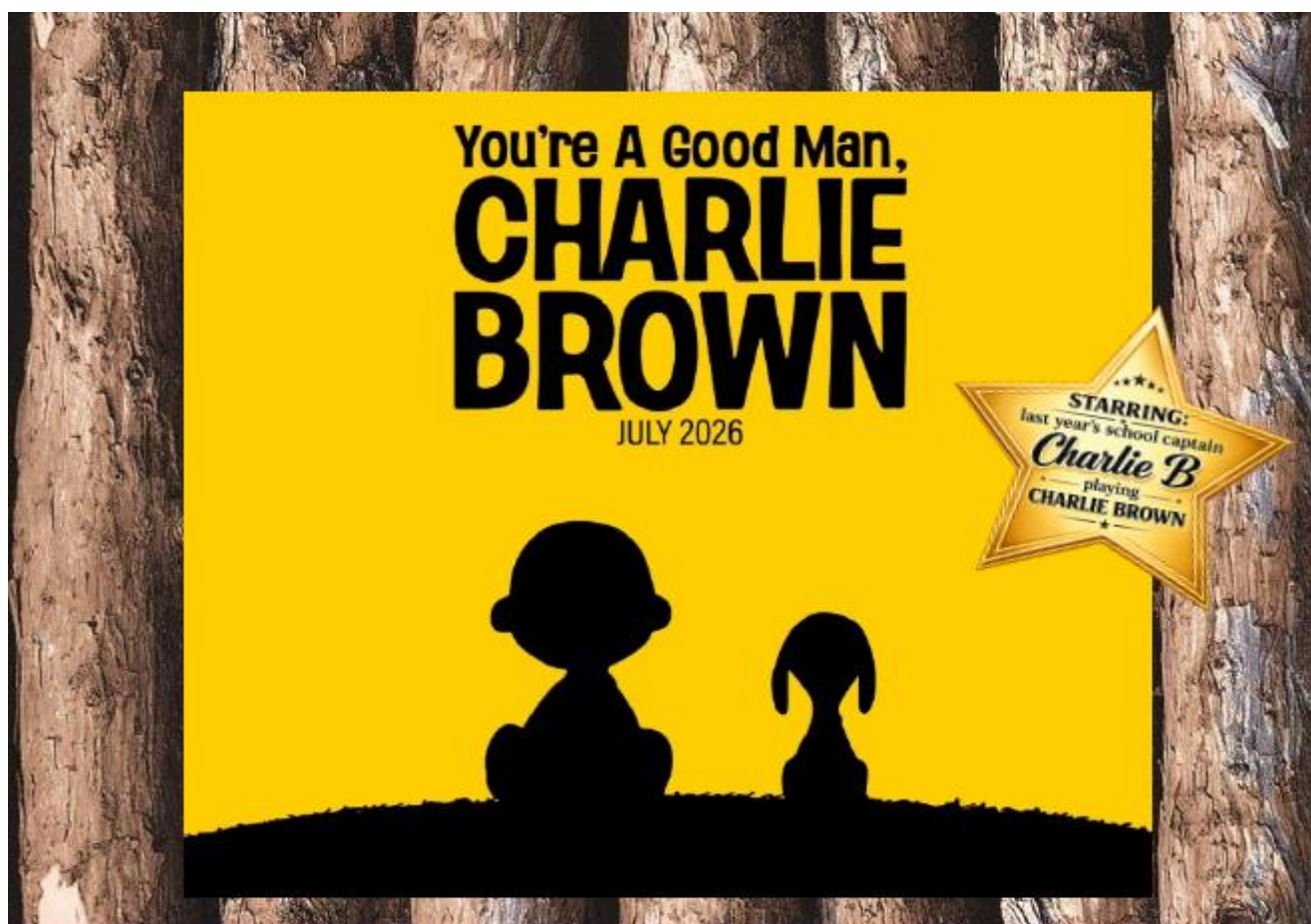

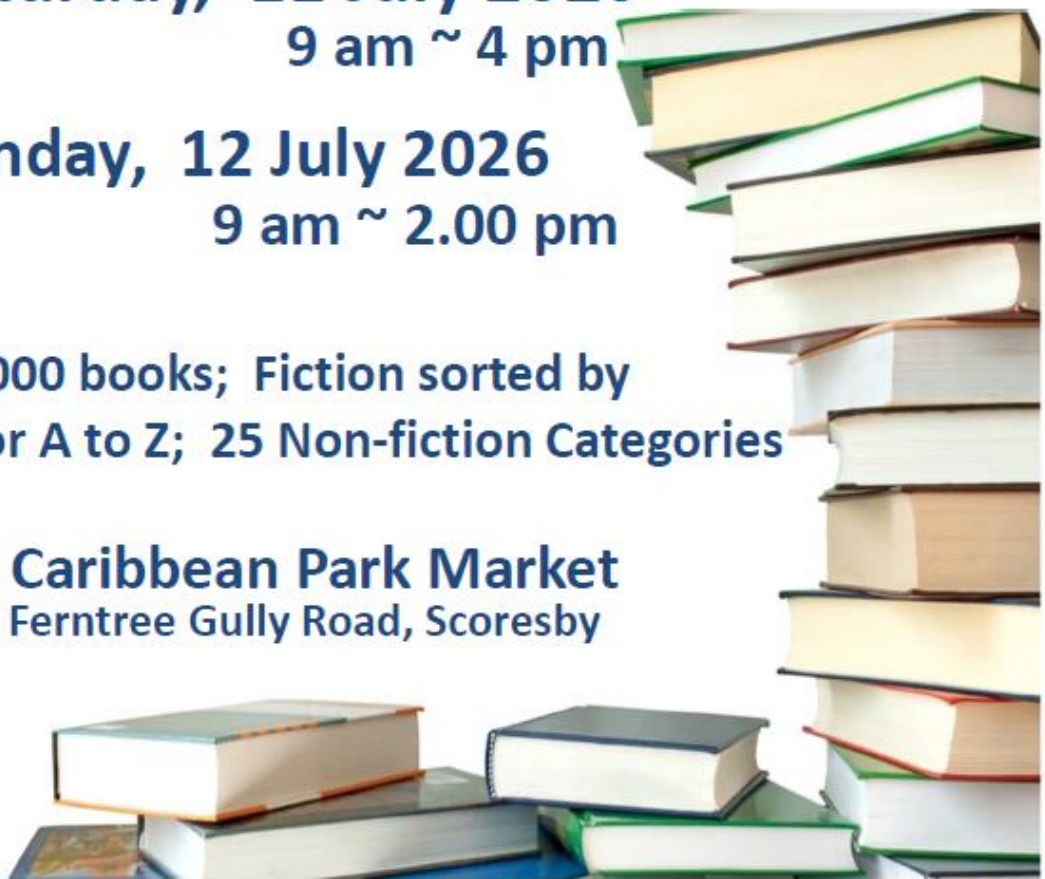
